Birth Certificates and rosters required for all players and teams (15-man maximum roster for tournament). Players turning 11 years of age before 5/01/08 are **INELIGIBLE. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

1. Six (6) innings, one hour and 30 minutes time limit.
2. Maximum of 5 runs per inning, once 5 runs are scored, offensive team goes to defense. **(Unlimited runs during each teams last inning to bat)**
3. Guaranteed three (3) games.
4. High School Rules
 - A. 65 ft. bases
 - B. You can lead-off
5. Baseballs: Each team provides two (2) new balls per game. Tournament Committee keeps balls when games are completed.

6. Home team determined by a flip of coin.
7. Batting: You may choose to bat one of the following ways: (Once your line-up is established it must stay intact)
 - a) Nine (9) batters
 - b) Ten (10) batters – extra hitter allowed
8. Pitcher: cannot pitch more than six (6) innings a day, or no more than twelve (12) innings for the weekend.
9. Catcher: dropped ball on third strike is an automatic out. (Runners can advance to any base at their own risk).
10. Fielding: Real Baseball. (Only three (3) outfielders at one time.)
11. Runners: can lead-off
12. **All players must be in uniform. Coaches must be in uniform or baseball shorts, baseball or tennis shoes. (No tank tops, flip-flops, jeans, etc.) This will be strictly enforced.**
13. ONLY players and four (4) coaches allowed in dugouts. THIS WILL BE ENFORCED!! **No Parents or Non-Players are allowed in the Dugout!**
14. Tied Game: Only in POOL PLAY will a tied game be considered as such. In BRACKET PLAY one (1) extra inning will be played; if still tied after that extra inning, a runner will be placed at 2nd base. (California Rule).

Tie Breaker:

1. Best record in pool.
2. Head to head.
3. Runs scored minus runs allowed. (No more than 10 runs for a victory or a loss)
4. Least runs allowed.
5. Coin flip.

2. If WEATHER does not permit games, the tournament director has authority to change game times.
3. Awards will be: 1st and 2nd place team trophies and individual medals for 1st and 2nd place teams (15 players maximum).
